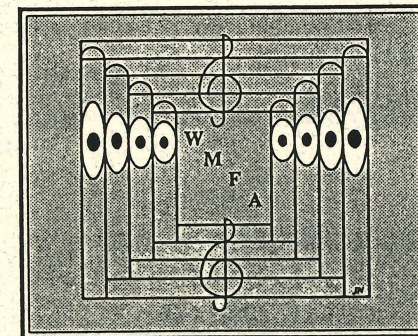

Darlene Dugan, is a flute instructor for Calvin, Cornerstone, Grand Rapids Community and Kalamazoo Colleges and has her own studio. She has taught at the Western Michigan High School Seminars, the Kalamazoo Chamber Music Workshops, and at Interlochen. Since retiring as a theory instructor and flute choir director at GRCC in 1990, she has conducted the Calvin College Flute Choir, a flute choir at the National Flute Association Convention in Los Angeles, and has performed with NFA and Michigan professional flute choirs. Darlene has been principal flute of the Kalamazoo Symphony and Chamber Orchestra, the Grand Rapids and Amarillo, Texas Symphonies and a member of orchestras in Seattle, Wichita, and the Aspen Festival Orchestra.

Shaul Ben-Meir, flutist of the Detroit Symphony Orchestra and Renaissance Woodwind Quintet, appears regularly in solo recitals and master classes across the country. He has recorded solo albums with Golden Crest, Coronet, and Megido Records. Founder and director of the Michigan Flute Orchestra, Mr. Ben-Meir was invited to conduct the 1991 NFA professional flute choir. He has arranged many compositions for flute choir. He performed at the 1976, 1977, and 1980 NFA conventions and served as a judge for the 1980 Young Artist and Orchestral competitions. He won the silver medal at the International Wind Instruments Competition in Helsinki and was principal flutist of the Haifa Symphony, visiting professor of music at Ithaca College, and an artist-in-residence at the University of Buffalo. Mr. Ben-Meir studied in his native Israel and in England. His teachers include Geoffrey Gilbert, Joseph Mariano, and Jean-Pierre Rampal.
