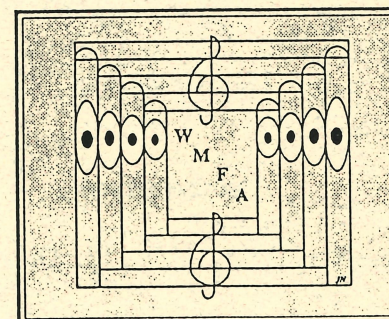

Ms. Dugan has been principal flute of the Kalamazoo Symphony and Chamber Orchestra, the Grand Rapids and Amarillo, Texas Symphonies and a member of orchestras in Seattle, Wichita, and the Aspen Festival Orchestra.
